Mr. Willie Byrd Archie, 99, was born to the late Charlie R. Archie, Sr. and the late Pearl Green Archie in Winston-Salem, North Carolina on September 11, 1917. He attended the local schools of Winston-Salem and was a former member of Mount Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church.

Mr. Archie worked for a short period of time at RJ Reynolds Tobacco Company. He subsequently went to work as an optician in the office of Dr. McIntosh Hedrick and he retired after twenty-nine years of dedicated service in that profession, from Dr. Hedrick's office.
