 when life is done.

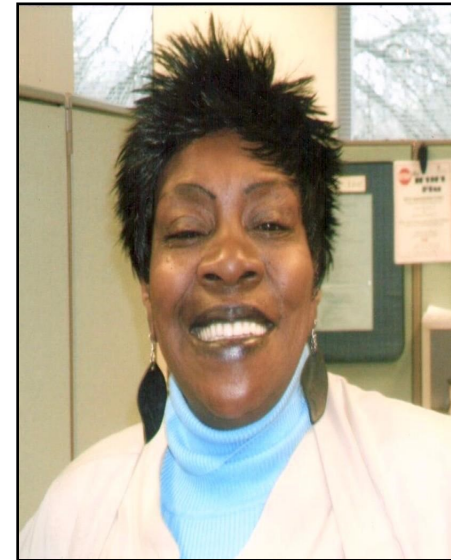
