

A Solution to Drug Abuse

- This plan provides for the decriminalization of Drug Abuse
- This plan allows for recovery without stigma
- This plan avoids the transportation of lethal drugs corrupting the pathway regions
- This plan allows and encourages purveyors of illegal drugs to reform, cease and desist from such activity without harm
- This plan provides for the unwitting casually involved persons to avoid any stigma
- This plan allows and encourages all who wish to help reform the addicted a facility to do so

A Solution to Drug Abuse

The federal government shall fund an agency or non-government organization to provide and operate a "Drug Colony" in some very remote and isolated area. The Drug Colony will have two completely separate facilities. One will be the "Drug Free" area and the other will be the "Free Drug" area.

All persons convicted of possession of illegal drugs will be sent to the Drug Colony. There they will choose residence in either area which will be a basic and stark existence. After six months in the "Drug Free" area, they will be returned home and all records of their involvement will be expunged. This may be repeated indefinitely as each offence is a first time event.

Drugs provided the Free Drug area will be refined and processed on site from the imported raw materials so that the lethal drugs consumed in the Colony will not contaminate other regions as they are transported..

Purveyors of illegal drugs will also be remanded to the Drug Colony and thereon will make their choice of facility. All purveyors of illegal drugs will be sentenced to "Death-Suspended". Upon the conviction of the second offence, the suspension will be lifted.
