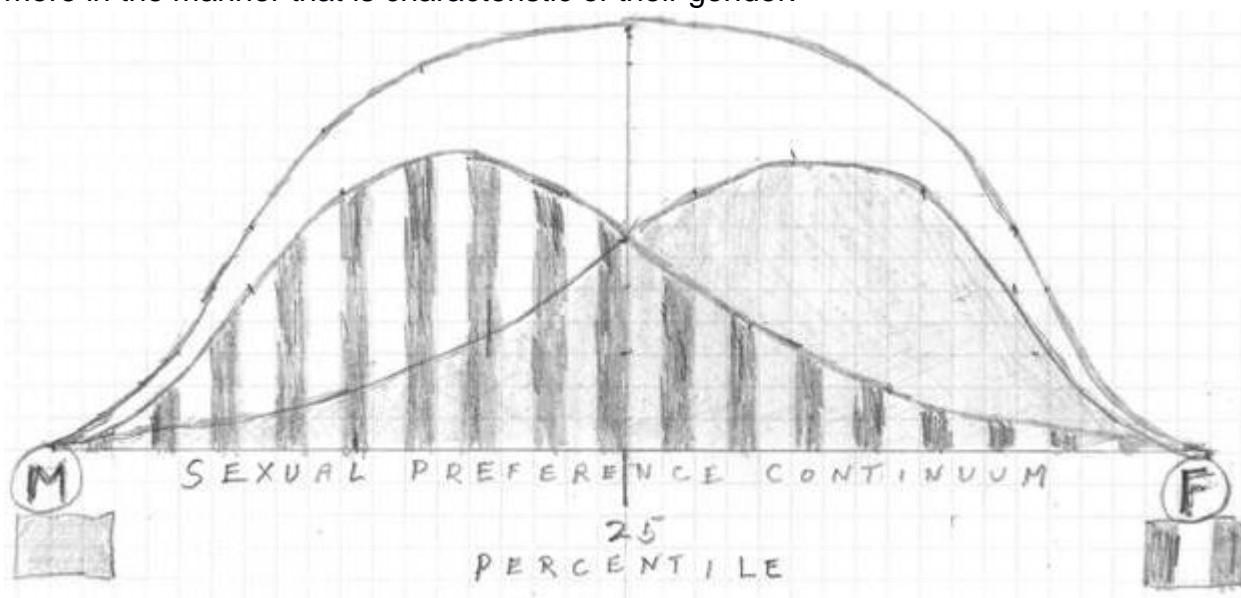


The Beach Sexual Difference Continuum Analysis

Here I have extended my "Sexual Preference Continuum Analysis" to difference between the manner in which males and females process information and concepts. Because everyone views the world from different positions of the continuum, communication about this concept is difficult.

This analysis shows that those at the twenty-five percentile –both females and males – process information and concepts essentially the same. Those below the twenty-five percentile process information and concepts ever more in the manner of the opposite gender. Those above the twenty-five percentile process information and concepts ever more in the manner that is characteristic of their gender.



This analysis can help one better find one's self on the spectrum or continuum and better understand why other's view of the world differs from their own.

This can help the understanding of "inequalities" in the societal fabric. It is easily recognized that there is a gender distinction in the National Football League and in the Maternity Ward. But when it comes to thought processes, the distinction become murky and difficult to apply fairly. However murky it may be, denial of the *intrinsic difference* is not tenable. And yet, this analysis shows that from the perspective of any one person on the continuum, denial can seem very tenable.
