## **REPORTING TO RESIDENTS**

1. Following an investigation into a resident's allegation of sexual abuse suffered in the facility, Tomorrow's Hope (TH) and/or the contractor shall inform the resident as to whether the allegation has been determined to be substantiated, unsubstantiated, or unfounded.

- 2. The local PREA coordinator shall request the relevant information from the investigative agency in order to inform the resident.
- 3. Following a resident's allegation that a staff member has committed sexual abuse against the resident, TH and/or the contracting agency shall subsequently inform the resident (unless the agency has determined that the allegation is unfounded) whenever:
  - 1. The staff member is no longer posted within the resident's unit;
  - 2. The staff member is no longer employed at the facility;
  - 3. It's learned that the staff member has been indicted on a charge related to sexual abuse within the facility; or
  - 4. It's learned that the staff member has been convicted on a charge related to sexual abuse within the facility.
- 4. Following a resident's allegation that he or she has been sexually abused by another resident, TH and/or the contractor shall subsequently inform the alleged victim whenever TH receives authorization by the contracting agency that the alleged abuser has been indicted or convicted on a charge related to sexual abuse within the facility.
- 5. All such notifications or attempted notifications shall be documented.
- 6. TH obligation to report shall terminate if the resident is released from the agency's custody.
