• A person's attitude toward himself has a profound influence on his attitudes toward God, his family, his friends, his future, and many other significant areas of his life.


FORMING ATTITUDES ABOUT OURSELVES

 One of the major areas of conflict in both youth and adults is that of having wrong attitudes about ourselves. These attitudes affect every other relationship in our life.

- When the most attractive and popular students on a certain campus were asked if they were satisfied with their basic appearance, over 95 percent replied that they were not!
- These students were aware of their basic sin nature and their need for salvation. They had placed their faith in Jesus Christ and had been reborn by the Spirit of God.
- But many were having continued struggles in the matter of dedicating their lives to the will of God. In further discussions with them, it was discovered that they had inwardly reasoned that if what they saw in the mirror was an example of God's love and creativity for them, they couldn't really trust Him with their future.



BASIC INSIGHTS ON SELF-ACCEPTANCE

• In order to accept the unchangeable features in ourselves which God has made, we must see the insights of a much bigger picture.
