- Was at the forefront of the fight against European fascism; for women's political rights, economic equality, and reproductive rights; and for sexual education for adolescents, over 80 years ago?
- Opened the first psychoanalytic clinics for poor people in Europe, and paid for it with his own money, over 75 years ago?

- Coined the term "Sexual Revolution" to describe the struggle of women and men everywhere to establish happy and healthy love lives over 70 years ago?
- Introduced energy medicine in America over 65 years ago?
- Discovered an energy previously unknown to science, which he called "orgone," and designed a device to use the energy to perform healing experiments over 65 years ago?
