

is time to pray to God for faith if you do not have it. It is urgently important to believe in

your heart. Everything depends on it. What you believe in your heart determines what you believe will happen today, tonight and tomorrow. Your faith determines, not only whether you have eternal life. It determines how you face the day, interact with others, and even how you sleep. Your faith determines how you look towards the day and its affairs and the night with its activities. Faith determines what you do and think when you are alone and with others. Faith determines how you respond to the good, the bad, the ugly, and the sad. Faith determines how you treat and think about God, yourself, and others. Hebrews 11:1 provides an operational definition of faith. "It is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen." Therefore, we know what we see requires no faith and what we do not see requires faith. When we wake from sleep, we hope to make it through the rest of the day. As we face trials of the day, we hope to succeed. When we finish whatever the day brought, we move to the next event. Finally, as we return to sleep, we realize we made it through the day, winning some and maybe not winning all the day's battles, to our satisfaction. However, as we lay down to sleep, we hope for safety through the night and for waking again tomorrow. But that is the substance of our hope. What is the evidence? To begin to answer this question, be mindful that we are talking about the evidence of things we don't see as a measure of our faith. When we begin to lay our burdens down at Jesus' feet, we are operating in faith. When we lay down sin, temptation, greed, pride, hate, shame, fear, guilt, and malice, and cast these burdens upon Christ (whose burdens are light), we experience the freedom to live in this world, in love, peace, harmony, hope, and contentment. These changes occur in our secret, unobservable parts, such as in our hearts, minds, and souls. Your peace of mind is the evidence that you have cast your burden on God in faith and hope. When you have peace in this world and have peace with God, you are not bearing these evil burdens. Jesus is bearing them for you. The peace you experience, even without any real changes in your situation, is the evidence of your faith. The conditions of our personal situations and those of the world may not change. However, the way we think and respond to them changes. When we begin to cast every burden on Jesus, we are no longer bearing the burden. If Jesus is bearing it, He does not need us to bear it. You will overcome whatever and whoever is involved in your fear, anger, sadness, unforgiveness, or malicious thoughts, when you truly and humbly give them to Jesus. He works out all things to the good of those who love Him and are called to His purpose (faith). Whatever you are going through, if you cast it upon Jesus, it is no longer your burden. ## HAPPY 245TH BIRTHDAY TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (1776-2021)

Let us pray for and thank God for the United States of America, as we celebrate the nation's independence from Great Britain on July 4, 1776. As a trickle of interest, Thomas Jefferson and John Adams, besides signing the Declaration of Independence, both became presidents of the USA and both died on July 4, some years later. Also, President John Coolidge was born on July 4. Finally the following may interest you:

**Thomas Jefferson** chaired the committee which drafted the Declaration of Independence. He was only a single voice among the others, although he was the chairman. Mr. Jefferson had written an accusatory clause, against King GeorgeIII, stating that the King had introduced and enforced slavery in the Colonies. Jefferson , a slave-owner, himself, also referred to slavery as an abominable crime. The final official draft of the Declaration of Independence, on July 4, 1776 omitted Jefferson's remarks concerning King George III. The advancement of the fight against slavery persisted through the Civil War, the Emancipation Proclamation, and the 13th Amendment.

However, **Frederick Douglass** raised a question in one of his speeches on July 5, 1852, "What to the slave is the Fourth of July?"

Now, this brings us to President Joseph Biden and the Federal government's proclamation of **Juneteenth as a national holiday, beginning June 19, 2021**!!! It was a long time coming, but it has arrived!!! Thank God for this milestone for which so many fought, sweated, bled, and died.
