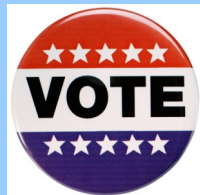

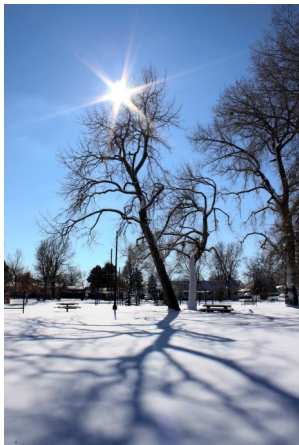
**Holiday Concert
