# Don's Retirement Lunch:

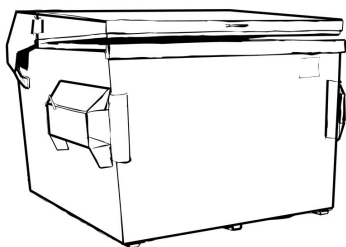
Say it isn't so!! Don is retiring the end of May!! Mr Wonderful is leaving us. He will be very much missed!!
