Speaker Bios



Sean Barclay is a Creative Director, Developer and Animator based out of San Francisco, California. He studied graphic design and technology at the Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT), where he explored print, interactivity, and animation. His focus is interactive software, typography, generative art, motion graphics, mobile and gestural technology. He blends the worlds of advanced technology and interactive design to create new engaging experiences that help users remember and embrace as they interact. During his 15-year career, he has had the privilege to do work with Adidas, Avaya, BlackRock, Biogen, Charles Schwab, Dolby, E-Trade, Harvard, IBM, Intel, Netgear, Philips, O'Neill, Reebok, RSA Security, and Samsung. Sean is one of the founding members of IBM Blockchain, and leads creative for the emerging business unit.



Mike Belshe is a veteran technologist and inventor of the multi-signature protocols used at BitGo. Prior to BitGo, Mike worked at Google on the founding team of Google Chrome and was the inventor of SPDY (which has now become HTTP/2.0). Prior to that he co-founded Lookout Software, an email search company acquired by Microsoft. He holds a C.S. degree from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.



Noga Golan is the President of the International Blockchain Real Estate Association (IBREA.) Noga is dedicated to implementing the blockchain technology in real estate and is especially passionate about bringing the technology to developing countries with problematic title systems. Prior to IBREA, Noga worked at Spear Street Capital, a U.S.-based real estate private equity firm, and served in the Israeli Defense Force as a Liaison Officer.



David Haimes is a Senior Director in the Oracle Research and Development Organization, with close to 20 years working in various roles on the development of the Financial Management product suite. He started with Oracle in the UK building features for EMEA, moving to Oracle HQ in Silicon Valley in 2000 to lead the team building a new module for Intercompany processing. He took on ownership of more products(having product management, Engineering and QA teams) for the new Fusion Cloud Financials Suite, built from the ground up for the cloud. He has also led a number of initiatives across the division including embedded BI, integrated social collaboration and data visualizations. Most recently he was responsible for design, build and launching, Accounting Hub Reporting Cloud Service which has for several years been generating millions of dollars in revenue every quarter. Since the summer of 2016 his focus is exclusively on working with customers and longer-term design work, particularly around next-generation functional and technical architecture. David's primary task is to figure out NOW what the financial management system of the next 3, 5 or more years should look like and start working toward it. Areas of interest are blockchain, AI and Machine Learning and new UX and interaction paradigms.
