First, let me say that our official name for the closet/ food pantry is 'Hope for Families (H_4F) - Clothing Closet / Food Pantry'.

When both Becky and Jan stepped down from the closet due to the health issues of their husbands, the running of the closet fell back into my hands. As you know, I am struggling also with Gene and his health. I truly had to get on my knees and say Lord, I can't take on the workings of the closet and give it what it needs to make it run. I ask Him, "You are going to have to send me volunteers - I don't even have the time to go looking for them. Please show me if our clothing closet has more service to give or have we completed our season of serving others through the clothing closet." He truly answered!

Within the past 4 weeks - the Lord sent one special lady and as she came, along came several more. Then 2 weeks ago the Metrolina Association called and they had a group coming from Lynchburg (Thomas Roads Baptist Church) and did I want them to come help. Along with that - the Missions Director for Metrolina ask if his wife and 2 boys could also come and give us a hand. Along with that - the summer missionary for Metrolina came. And along with that - six more came because of that one special lady mentioned above. And along with that - three members of my family came - with all this and myself we had a total of 20 volunteers just in one week to help process clothes and get the closet ready to open on July 11th. Since then, we have 7 regular worker's that come different days of the week and work. And that special lady has been VERY busy. Folks, He truly answered prayers. Now, about that very special lady mentioned above - her name is Jan Garmon - and Jan is a member of the First Baptist Church of Indian Trail. To make a long story short she has agreed to become the Director of the closet and to keep the service to our community and to Charlotte going. She has such a special heart for this mission work - after all - she was the reason we started this closet 6 years ago. She loves serving the Lord this way, just as Wanda, Becky, John, Jan, Hillary and Jamar did.

Below is a picture of Jan. I ask that you pray for her – that the Lord will continue to send volunteers – and that the closet will continue to show the Love of Jesus to all that enter.
