Joshua 1:2 "Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel"

Can you imagine being in Joshua's position? God is calling Joshua to lead his people into the Promised Land after the death of Moses. We can only imagine the stress, fear, and anxiety that Joshua must have felt. After all, Moses was the great deliverer of Israel, leading the people out of Egypt. He was the law giver having received God's Word from Mt. Sinai. He was the loving intercessor between God and the people. Now, Joshua is now responsible for taking Moses' place and leading Israel to conquer the Promised Land. If there was ever a moment where an individual needed to trust God and seek his encouragement, it was this moment.

But there is good news, God is always gracious and generous to his people. While the statement "Moses my servant is dead" could potentially cause great anxiety, Joshua 1:2 offers a greater and more powerful encouragement as the Lord declares to Joshua, "I am giving the land to you and to the people of Israel." If God has a purpose for our lives, He is going to provide all that we need to fulfill that purpose. This is the clear implication in Joshua 1. Repeatedly, the Lord's provision is emphasized. V. 2 "I am giving." V. 3 "I have given to you." V. 6, "I swore to their fathers to give them." V. 11, take possession of the land that the Lord your God is giving you." V. 13, "The Lord your God is providing you a place of rest and will give you the land." V. 15, "the Lord your God is giving them." The Lord is a gracious giver.

This encouragement is not exclusive to Israel, but for all of God's people. In 1 Corinthians 1:5-6, Paul thanks God that in every way He has enriched the Corinthians in all speech and knowledge, even as their testimony about Christ was confirmed. If you read 1 and 2 Corinthians, you know the many problems the Corinthian church had, yet, Paul is clear in his prayer that God gives them all that they need as His church.

Now matter what circumstances we are facing; we have two choices. We can either focus on our problems and hardship "Moses is dead," or we can focus on the faithfulness of God "I am giving." At New Hope, I pray that in all things, we will trust the Lord, seek his provisions and experience the full sufficiency of the Lord Jesus.

For those that ask - here is your recipe

Teresa's long lost Lasagna Recipe

1lb. Hamburger½ teaspoon dry oregano½ teaspoon sage¼ teaspoon pepper1 teaspoon garlic salt10 oz. lasagna noodles½ cup chopped onion3 cups cottage cheese½ cup chopped celery½ cup Parmesan cheese

½ cup chopped carrots 2 beaten eggs

16 oz. Can tomatoes
6 oz. Can tomato paste
1 lb. Mozzarella cheese
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Cook hamburger, sage, onion, celery and carrots until hamburger is lightly browned.

Drain off fat.

Stir in tomatoes, tomato paste, salt, oregano and first ¼ pepper.

Simmer uncovered for 30 minutes, stirring occasionally while that is cooking.

Cook the lasagna noodles by package directions, then drain noodles well. (I used pre-cooked noodles)

Combine cottage cheese, Parmesan cheese, eggs, parsley flakes and remaining pepper.

Place half the noodles in a greased 9x13 baking dish.

Spread half the cheese filling, half the mozzarella cheese and half the meat sauce.

Repeat the layers.

Baked uncovered for 30 minutes @ 350 degrees.

Let stand 10 to 15 minutes before serving.
