American Red Cross:

- Provides 10 comfort kit containing hygiene items Comfort kits, stored and ready for
 distribution nationwide, contain the basic personal supplies someone would need in the
 aftermath of a disaster. The kit contains deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, facial tissues,
 washcloth, shampoo, liquid soap, lotion, comb, razor, and shaving cream.
- Provides 3 comfort kit containing hygiene items and 2 blankets Comfort kits contain the basic personal supplies someone would need in the aftermath of a disaster.  Bring light to a little girl's bedroom, the first bedroom she has ever had that didn't have to be shared with her mom and older sister. It's the first place she has had to call her own.

Leak Street Alumni:

• Help purchase paper supplies for our after-school program.

New Horizon's Life and Family Services:

• Feed people in our shelter for a week or more through food purchased from the food bank.

Our Daily Bread:

- 137 lbs. of Frozen meat or canned vegetables from the Sandhills Food Bank
- 92.86 packs of Ramen Noodles.
- 75 lbs. of Rice

- 26-29oz cans of diced Tomatoes
- 29 cans of Hunts Spaghetti Sauce

Purchase 6 Home Delivered Meals to feed 6 homebound seniors 60 years old or older

Richmond County 4 H Clubs:

• Supply 3 scholarships for our monthly Movie Night. Movie night is on a Friday evening from 6 pm until 10 pm and is open to youth ages 5-12. Movie night was started to bring more youth into 4-H and give them a chance to have fun in a safe, educational environment. Fee includes dinner, 4 hours of parent freedom, games, and learning about 4-H.

Richmond County Rescue Squad:

• Fuel trucks and generators

Richmond County Schools – Exceptional Children:

Helps purchase gas for upcoming field trips.

Salvation Army:

• It could be the last few dollars a person needs to help with their eviction notice or disconnect notice. It might mean a roof over a family's head or heat on a cold night.

Samaritan Colony:

• With the average cost of \$3.00 per meal, we would be able to use \$26.00 to provide one of our clients with nutritious meals for three days.

- Buy an interactive game that could be adapted for use by a young child who has special developmental needs.
