Potential Complications When ADHD is Left Untreated

Preschool



 Low self-esteem and family disruptions

School Age



- Disruptive behaviors leading to family problems
- Poor social skills, including lying and stealing
- Can be uncooperative with peers, alienation
- Unwilling/unable to do chores
- Learning delays, homework struggles
- School failure
- Continued low self-esteem
- 35% of ADHD children also have ODD
- 25% of ADHD children also have Conduct Disorder

Teenagers



- A variety of academic and interpersonal problems
- Oppositional behaviors, temper outbursts, quick mood changes
- Lack of motivation
- Depression, low self-worth, inner sense of restlessness
- Increased risk of suicide
- Increased risk of traffic tickets and motor vehicle accidents
- Antisocial behaviors and activities, clashes with authority
- Smoking
- Substance abuse
- Sexually transmitted disease
- Pregnancy

Adults



- Difficulty organizing responsibilities, poor memory, emotional distress, irritability
- Frequent job changes
- Marital and social problems
- Increased risk of suicide, alcohol and drug use
- Depressive symptoms
- Up to 80% of children with ADHD do NOT outgrow it
