What is technocracy?

Technocracy is a system of governance where decision-makers are selected based on their expertise in science and technology rather than through traditional political means.

- It emphasizes control of society by an elite group who claim superior scientific know-how.
- This concept implies a highly controlled and surveilled society, where technology is used to monitor and influence behavior.

What is the prophetic significance of technocracy?

This tells us that in the end times, a one-world government under the Antichrist will arise.

Revelation 13:17 – *no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.*

The Mark of the Beast of Revelation 13 will use technology to control the economy.

- The Antichrist is not omniscient but will employ technology to appear so.

How will the Antichrist use AI to control the masses?

Revelation 13:15 – *He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed.*

Where have we seen technocracy in action?

What makes human technological enslavement possible?

- There are backdoor functions hidden in app software that allows governments and corporations to access your cell’s microphone and camera, even when you think the device is shut off.

Why is the loss of privacy a significant end times trend?

- Genesis Mission (Nov 24, 2025) making the expansion of AI a top priority as the, *"largest marshalling of federal scientific resources since the apollo program"* (Michael Kratsios, director of the White House Office of Science and Technology; leohohmann.com)

What is the Genesis Mission executive order expected to achieve?

Unlock federal data sets and enable autonomous, closed loop experimentation and massively accelerate the rate of scientific breakthroughs," such as the rate of new drug approvals.

- The result would be to "shorten discovery timelines from years to days or even hours" while "empowering scientists to test bolder hypotheses and discover breakthroughs that are currently unreachable."

What could possibly go wrong with turning the development of new medical treatments over to AI?

Leo Hohmann: "You can bet most of these new AI developed treatments will involve human genetic manipulation through mRNA injections and other methods."

What is the best defense against being misled by AI?

AI cannot mislead you unless you participate in the delusion that AI is infallible.

- Sadly, too many people use AI as the source, and this is what globalists want.
- The human laziness factor is, in a way, giving AI permission to rule over us.

What is the humanist view of how the AI technocratic threat can be resisted?

Idolatry... worshiping the image of the beast and the Beast himself is worshiping the creation instead of the Creator.
