Who Is Zohran Mamdani?

He is likely to become the mayor of New York City. He is both Islamic and a Marxist (what a combination).

- He was born in Kampala, Uganda, and raised in New York, where he was elected to the New York State Assembly in 2020.
- His mother is an internationally acclaimed Indian filmmaker whose body of work promotes themes of anti-colonial struggle, global inequality, and Western culpability—especially in Africa, India, and the Muslim world.
- His father is a Marxist political theorist born in India and raised in Uganda. A longtime professor at Columbia University, he is a prominent voice in pushing the concept of “imperial Islamophobia”—a theory that frames global counterterrorism efforts, secular governance, and Western critiques of Islam as modern forms of colonial repression.
 - In his view, terrorism is not an ideological threat, but a political byproduct of Western oppression.

What is the worldview of Mamdani's parents?

Their worldview fuses cultural grievance, academic Marxism, and postcolonial resistance into a political identity that views the West not as a civilizational force, but as a system to deconstruct.

How is Zohran Mamdani a prototype candidate for America's downfall?

He dresses up like your average progressive, throwing around slogans like “abolish ICE,” “free Palestine,” and “defund the police.” But beneath the buzzwords is a two-

headed agenda: Marxist revolution dressed in Islamic grievance politics.

- His political base is the Democratic Socialists of America (DSA)—an organization that openly advocates for the dismantling of capitalism.

Mamdani publicly identifies as a Shia Muslim.

- However, his engagement with religion appears selectively political: he has remained publicly silent on theocratic abuses by Islamic regimes—including Iran, Qatar, and the Palestinian Authority—while simultaneously criticizing Western nations for “Islamophobia” and colonialism.

Why is there an allegiance between Marxist economics and Islamic grievance politics?

There is an informal but growing alliance between far-left political actors and Islamist organizations or sympathizers, united by a common opposition to Western structures, capitalism, and the state of Israel.

- This isn't solidarity. It's hatred of a common enemy: Judeo-Christian civilization,
- Islam despises everything the Left claims to stand for—gay rights, feminism, pluralism—but they make common cause because both hate the West.

How can we characterize Mamdani's worldview?

He believes nearly every institution in America is tainted by racism, capitalism, or imperialism.

- What he offers is not reform. It's replacement. And his growing popularity among youth voters suggests that the fusion he represents is no longer fringe—it's fast becoming the foundation of a new political orthodoxy.

Was Mamdani's rise solely on the basis of ideology?

No, Mamdani's rise was engineered by a system of allies, donors, and activists who knew precisely what they were building.

- Behind the “community organizer” act is a political apparatus that grooms candidates like Mamdani to smuggle Marxist-Islamist ideology into American institutions under the banner of democracy.
- The DSA ran his field ops, crafted his messaging, and cast his campaign as part of their strategy to mainstream socialism through identity politics.

What endorsements did Mamdani receive?

- **Justice Democrats**—the engine behind Ilhan Omar, Rashida Tlaib, and AOC. Their specialty? Recruiting candidates who check every radical box: anti-Zionist, redistributionist, and committed to dismantling U.S. institutions in the name of “equity.”
- **Working Families Party (WFP)**—the ballot-access brigade for socialist hardliners. They delivered campaign infrastructure, online reach, and grassroots clout among college-age radicals.
- And orbiting all of it was the **Ceasefire Now Coalition**—a patchwork of BDS organizers, Hamas apologists, and pro-Palestinian front groups.

Also, a who’s-who of radical Islamists and Marxists:

- **Linda Sarsour**—the Sharia-defending, Hamas-flirting activist who’s been banned from feminist events for being too extreme. She promoted Mamdani as if he were her own campaign.
- **Senator Bernie Sanders** – approved by America’s most famous democratic socialist.
- **Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez** – Didn’t just endorse—she campaigned with him.
- **NY Attorney General Letitia James**
A statewide official who’s supposed to rise above partisanship. Her endorsement tore that mask off.
- And a plethora of DSA-aligned.

Why was Mamdani’s campaign so successful?

It wasn’t a campaign. It was a coalition trial run—designed to prove that if you mix DSA slogans, Islamic grievance politics, and anti-Israel rage, you can raise millions, go viral, and walk into public office without ever answering a real question.

- And now, it’s not theory anymore... It worked.

Why do we see Islam and Marxism partnering up?

Islam and Marxism, though often perceived as very different, actually share significant common ground, especially in their political and ideological aims.

- Islam, is not merely a religion in the traditional sense but is a political ideology focused on world conquest through the imposition of Sharia law.
- Similarly, Marxism is a political and economic ideology aimed at global conquest through the overthrow of existing systems and the redistribution of wealth.
- Both Islam and Marxism seek totalitarian control and have a shared agenda of subduing nations under their respective systems.
- Both ideologies give license to radical actions, including terrorism, as a means to achieve their ends.

Why is the alliance between Islam and Marxism called the "Red-Green Axis"?

Because Marxists (red) and Islamists (green) cooperate because "the enemy of my enemy is my friend."

- They unite against common adversaries, particularly Western nations and Israel, despite their differing ultimate goals.

Why is the "Red-Green Axis" alliance temporary?

Eventually, they will turn against each other and Islam will come out on top.

Revelation 17:17 – *For God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast*

Islam despises everything the Left claims to stand for—gay rights, feminism, pluralism—but they make common cause because both hate the West.

How does Islam & Marxism align with biblical principles?

- Both contradict biblical principles...

Marxism opposes the biblical institution of labor, which teaches that one must work to eat...

Genesis 3:17-19 – *Then to Adam He said, 'Because you listened to the voice of your wife, and ate from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat from it; cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life. Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; and you shall eat the plants of the field; By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread, till you return to the ground*

Islam opposes biblical teachings and is considered by some as an Antichrist system that rewrites biblical history and theology.

1 Timothy 4:1 – *But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons.*

Why have Christians been so complacent in the face of the growing cultural influence of the Red-Green Axis?

It’s due to their targeted psychological warfare... cultural forces have managed to convince Christians that their faith means never resisting, never judging, and never fighting back.

- Today’s Christians have been culturally castrated. They conflate cowardice with piety and mistake surrender for sanctity.
- Most Christians remain silent in the face of the growth in Islamic influence, having been conditioned to believe that resisting any of it is “unloving.”

What is the prophetic significance of the growing Red-Green Axis?

If foreshadows and sets the stage for what is to come, an Islamic Antichrist overseeing a Marxist economy.

How do we know the economy of the Antichrist will be Marxist?

The economy of the Antichrist will certainly have some characteristics taken from Marxism, especially in its approach to wealth redistribution and control.

Daniel 11:24 – *he shall disperse among them the plunder, spoil, and riches*

The Antichrist will do this under a guise of compassion but is fundamentally a tool of control.

What makes us think the Antichrist will be Islamic?

- He has to be a Gentile – Rev 13:1 says he emerges from the “sea” which is symbolic of Gentile nations... contrasted with the False Prophet who comes from the earth (or land, Rev 13:11), symbolic of Israel
- The Antichrist is referred to as “the Assyrian” in Isaiah 14:25-26 & Micah 5:2-6 (see the 4/6/2025 Deep Dive).
- The Syrian ruler Antiochus Epiphanes was a type of the Antichrist foreshadowing the Abomination of Desolation by sacrificing a pig to Zeus in the temple.

Doesn't Daniel indicate the Antichrist will be from the Revived Roman Empire?

Daniel 9:26 – *After the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary*

The Assyrian Empire territory was part of the Old Roman Empire. But this doesn't mean the Antichrist must be from Europe.

- In context, the “prince who is to come” refers to the Antichrist and he is of the people who destroyed Jerusalem and the temple in 70 A.D.
- History tells us that the Roman army did this; Josephus said it was the Fretensis (10th) legion that destroyed the temple.
- While the Roman 10th legion had Roman leadership, it was made up of soldiers from what is now Syria and Turkey.

So, this should lead us to expect the Antichrist to come from this region which may mean he'd be Muslim.

How does Nebuchadnezzar's dream in Daniel 2:37-45 reinforce the idea of an Islamic Antichrist?

The materials of the statue represent Gentile empires that would rule over Israel until the Messiah returns.

Gold – Babylonian Empire

Silver – Medes & Persians

Bronze – Greek Empire

Iron – Roman Empire

Iron & Clay – Government of the Antichrist

As the materials in the statue in Nebuchadnezzar's dream got progressively less valuable, each succeeding government gets weaker.

- There is inherent weakness in democracies as opposed to monarchies. They went from an absolute monarchy to an increasing sharing of power with others including their citizens.

Each of these kingdoms come into power by military conquest.

Could the “clay” represent something other than a Gentile government ruling over Israel?

No, it would be a category error... it has to refer to the Ottoman Empire and Islamic oppression of Israel.

How is it that the iron and clay kingdoms do not adhere to one another?

- The rule of the Temple Mount in Jerusalem have vacillated between the Revived Roman and Ottoman empires “*until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled*” (Luke 21:24).

These cultures not being able to mix will cause there to be conflict between Islam and Western Civilization until Christ returns to end all wars.

- While Islamists have enclaves in Western nations and visa versa, there is virtually no assimilation either way.

Why would Israel confirm a 7-year covenant with an Islamic ruler (Daniel 9:27)?

The secular rulers of modern Israel covet peace and will make a deal with the devil himself if that what it takes.

John 5:43 – *I have come in My Father's name, and you do not receive Me; if another comes in his own name, him you will receive.*

Israel has made such peace treaties with Islamic rulers in the past (Egypt & Jordan).

How else do we know that Islam will be a major influence during the Tribulation?

Revelation 20:4 – *I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands.*

Beheading will be the primary means of execution during the Tribulation. This is the preferred means of execution in Islam today.

What applications do we see from this discussion?

- The rapid growth of the Red-Green Axis foreshadows the government of the Antichrist.
- Islam has a major role in end-times prophecy.
