What is the cause of all the anti-Semitism in the world?

History has shown that at various times over the last 1,700 years the Jews have been expelled from over 80 different countries. Historians and experts have concluded there are at least six possible reasons:

- Racial Theory the Jews are hated because they are an inferior race.
- Economic Theory the Jews are hated because they possess too much wealth and power.
- Outsiders Theory the Jews are hated because they are different from everyone else.
- Scapegoat Theory the Jews are hated because they are the cause for all the world's problems.
- Deicide Theory the Jews are hated because they killed Jesus Christ.
- Chosen People Theory the Jews are hated because they arrogantly declare they are the "chosen ones of God."

Is there any substance to the racial theory for hating Jews?

This is just garden-variety racism. There is never any justification for hating someone because of their race. There is only one race, the human race...

Acts 17:26 – He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth

The idea that there are inferior races is the fruit of the anti-God theory of Darwinian evolution.

• Darwin's "Origin of Species" had a subtitle: 'the preservation of favoured races'.

The different races emerged following the dispersion of humanity following the Tower of Babel. As people cloistered by language groups, genetic differences emerged due to descendants coming from a sub-set of the gene pool.

Is there any substance to the economic theory for hating Jews?

This doesn't hold much weight. History has shown that during the 17th through 20th centuries, especially in Poland and Russia, the Jews were desperately poor and thus had little, if any, influence in business or politics.

Is there any substance to the outsiders' theory for hating Jews?

During the 18th century, the Jews desperately tried to assimilate with the rest of Europe. They had hoped that assimilation would cause anti-Semitism to disappear. Of course, in this the Jews were trying to buck what God said would be the case:

Malachi 3:6 – For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob

Is there any substance to the scapegoat theory for hating Jews?

The idea that the Jews are the source of the world's problems is just an excuse for hatred and since the Jews have always been hated, this makes them a convenient target.

Deuteronomy 28:65 – And among those nations you shall find no rest, nor shall the sole of your foot have a resting place; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing eyes, and anguish of soul.

Is there any substance to the idea that Jews are hated because they killed Jesus Christ?

The Bible makes it clear that the Romans were the ones who actually killed Jesus, though Jews were accomplices. It wasn't until a few hundred years later that the Jews were cited as the murderers of Jesus. One wonders why the Romans are not the ones hated. Jesus Himself forgave the Jews...

Luke 23:34 – Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

It is amazing that those who call themselves Christians would use this excuse for their hatred. This is why Jesus came

Mark 10:45 – For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

Is there any substance to idea that the Jews are hated because they are the chosen ones of God?

The Jews are God's chosen people to bless humanity through God's Word and the Messiah...

Deuteronomy 7:7 – The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples

But the Jews in Germany rejected their "chosen-ness" status during the later part of the 19th century to better assimilate into German culture. Nevertheless, they suffered the Holocaust.

• Today, some Christians and Muslims claim to be the "chosen people" of God, yet for the most part, the world tolerates them and still hates the Jews.

Why is it the world really hates the Jews?

The world hates the Jews because the world hates God. The Jews were God's firstborn, His chosen people...

Deuteronomy 14:2 – For you are a holy people to the Lord your God, and the Lord has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples who are on the face of the earth.

Through the Jewish patriarchs, the prophets, and apostles, God used the Jews to bring forth His Word, to a world of sin. And He sent forth His son, Jesus the Christ, in a Jewish body to redeem the world of sin.

• Satan, the prince of the earth (John 14:30; Ephesians 2:2), has poisoned the minds of men with his hatred of the Jews.

How has Satan influenced people to wipe out the Jews?

Satan has tried to wipe out the Jews through the Egyptians, the Assyrians, the Babylonians, the Persians, and the Nazis. But he's failed every time.

When did the conflict between God's chosen people and Gentiles begin?

The ancient hatred of God's chosen people began with the descendants of Ismael who was Abraham's first-born. Abraham and Sara arranged for Ismael to be born because they sought to have descendants ahead of God's plan. Ismael is considered to be the father of the Arabs and the prophecy about his descendants have been seen in history...

Genesis 16:12 – He shall be a wild man; his hand shall be against every man, and every man's hand against him. And he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.

How do we know God is not done with the Jews?

Daniel 9:24 – Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

God promised the Jews that He would use them to accomplish six objectives:

- The first three were accomplished when Jesus paid the penalty for our sins: to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity
- The remaining three will be accomplished when Jesus returns: to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy

Who is "your people" in Daniel 9:24?

This has to be Israel...

Could "your people" of Daniel 9:24 Spiritually include the church?

This would be too big of a stretch because:

- 1. The church didn't even exist for the first three things the Messiah would accomplish
- 2. The context is "your holy city" which has to be Jerusalem... What would be the holy city of the church? Rome? I don't think so.

What does it mean to finish the transgression?

Taken literally, this means establishing an entirely new order on earth, with an end to man's rebellion against God. Romans 8:7-9 – the carnal mind is enmity against God;

Romans 8:7-9 – the carnal mind is enmity against God for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.

What does it mean to make an end of sins?

Taking these words at face value, this means not only the end of the guilt of sin, but an end of sin itself. It means to "seal up" or to "restrain" sins. This looks to a new, redeemed body of people, the church.

Acts 10:43 – To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins.

What does it mean to make reconciliation for iniquity?

Man's iniquity must be reconciled to God's justice and holiness. This work was clearly accomplished at the cross. Romans 5:10 – For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

What does it mean to bring in everlasting righteousness?

This was accomplished spiritually at the cross because the righteousness of Christ is imputed to those who trust in Him...

2 Corinthians 5:21 – He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him

But this will be more fully realized during the Millennial Kingdom when most of the curse will be removed and God's people will never die.

Isaiah 11:4 – But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth

What does it mean to seal up vision and prophecy?

This speaks of both the ending and fulfillment of prophecy, concluding the final stage of human history and culminating with the reign of the Son of God.

Daniel 12:4 – But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase

What does it mean to anoint the Most Holy?

Jesus Christ will be anointed as King over all the earth when He returns to establish His Millennial Kingdom. The title "Christ" means "God's Anointed" but He will not be recognized as King over all the earth until He returns...

Revelation 19: 16 – He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Where do we see the church in Daniel's 70 weeks of years?

One has to employ Replacement Theology to think the church will be the agent God uses is to achieve any of this.

- The first 69 weeks of years was fulfilled when Jesus went to the cross. God has been working through the church since then... the gap between the 69th and 70th weeks of years (not part of the 70 weeks of years).
- God will resume working through Israel again for the final 70th week of years.

Romans 11:26 – all Israel will be saved
