Will technology render elections obsolete?

Klaus Schwab, the high priest of the WEF certainly thinks so. And why not? We are using technology to facilitate elections today and this has contributed to the current distrust in the integrity of elections.

- Hiding the fixing of elections is hard work, why not just do away with them entirely?

Why is there so much distrust in the integrity of our elections?

Once upon a time, we had an election day where it was expected to vote in person and mail in votes were the rare exception that had to be mailed early enough to be counted on election day. And we knew the results of the election at the end of the election day.

- Now with all of our early voting, digital voting machine technology and bending over backwards to accommodate mail in voters, we rarely know the results of an election at the end of the election day.
- There have been all kinds of election irregularities reported, especially for the 2020 election and nothing ever happens to prosecute the perpetrators.
- There is censorship for even questioning the integrity of an election (considered anti-democracy)
- Jan 6 election protesters treated as insurrectionists
- As Joseph Stalin said, “*I consider it completely unimportant who in the party will vote, or how; but what is extraordinarily important is this—who will count the votes, and how.*”

- J.B. Hixson: I no longer vote because our elections have become more like selections for some time. (My comment: This is probably true that our elections are really selections but this does not mean we should not vote...)

Will voting be around when the Antichrist comes to power?

Probably since the “appearance” of democracy will likely still be important. But elections will not be much of a factor in the Antichrist coming to power...

Daniel 11:21 – *he shall come in peaceably, and seize the kingdom by intrigue.*

It is possible the Ten Kings and maybe even the Antichrist are voted in but it is more likely they are simply appointed by locally elected officials as is the case in the European Union today. If there is a direct election involved, fraud will likely to be involved because the Antichrist seizes power *by intrigue*.

How is election fraud a sign of the times?

Election fraud is just one more manifestation of deception, and growing deception is a birth pang...

Matthew 24:11 – *many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.*

Among the characteristics of *the last days perilous times* in 2 Timothy 3:1-5 is *slanderers, despisers of good, and traitors...* all related to election fraud.

- *Slanderers*: using deception to get elected
- *Despisers of good*: making good, evil, and visa versa
- *Traitors*: ruling against the will of the people

In light of Romans 13, do elections really matter anyway?

Romans 13:1 – *Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.*

God is in control and raises up authorities to serve His purposes. Thus, when God appoints bad officials over us, we as a society are getting the leadership we deserve.

- The Christian should not be disconnected from politics: we are commanded to pray for our leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-4).

So, does God expect Christians to vote?

Even if our vote isn't counted by the worldly powers, how we vote does matter to God...

Ephesians 5:11 – have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them.

God, the Holy Spirit is restraining evil in this world and He is working through the church to do that.

2 Thessalonians 2:7 – For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way.

The Holy Spirit's ministry of restraining evil will end at the rapture of the church. But until then, we should work with the Spirit to restrain evil any way we can.

Is it important for Christians to be regarded as good citizens?

Certainly, as God's representatives on earth, Christians should be good citizens, and good citizens are expected to vote...

Titus 3:1 – Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work

How is voting a matter of good stewardship?

Not everyone has the opportunity to choose their leadership, it is a gift we should exercise...

1 Peter 4:10 – As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Can voting improve the condition of humanity on earth?

The evidence of sin's grip on this fallen world is everywhere. And much of the suffering on earth is because of godless leadership...

Proverbs 28:12 – When the righteous rejoice, there is great glory; but when the wicked arise, men hide themselves.

If enough Christians pray and vote to raise up godly leaders, the Lord will be moved to take action on our behalf.

Proverbs 14:34 – Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.

How should Christians vote?

Christians should vote as led through prayer and study of both God's Word and the realities of the choices on the ballot.

- Candidates or proposals that violate the Bible's commands for life, family, marriage, or faith should never be supported

How should we apply Christian principles in the way we vote?

It is the duty and responsibility of every Christian to vote for leaders promoting the most Christian principles (and voting against those promoting antichrist principles). God is certainly in control, but that does not mean we should do nothing to further His will.

- Scripture reveals that God has been displeased with our choices of leadership at times (Hosea 8:4).

Is choosing the lesser of two evils a legitimate way to vote?

The lesser of two evils is a saying that expresses a comparison of two bad or undesirable choices. Neither option is good, but the lesser of two evils seems to be the better choice because it is the less detrimental of the two.

- The poor choice of candidates in an election is a choice involving two less-than-sinful options, it is not really speaking about true moral evil...

1 Thess 5:22 – Abstain from every form of evil

What applications do we see from this discussion?

- Increasing election fraud is a birth pang; a sign of the times.
- Vote; our choices matter to God.
