What has been the bitter fruit of globalism?

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio’s powerful message at the Munich Security Conference boldly exposed the folly of globalist policies and how they have been used to undermine sovereignty, national strength, and the Judeo-Christian foundation of Western civilization.

- One particular statement was truly profound, and its tremendous accuracy stems from being bred out of a Biblical worldview...

[Discussing the collapse of Soviet communism in Germany, Rubio said:] “The euphoria of this triumph led us to a dangerous delusion: that we had entered, ‘the end of history;’ that every nation would now be a liberal democracy; that the ties formed by trade and by commerce alone would now replace nationhood; that the rules-based global order – an overused term – would now replace the national interest; and that we would now live in a world without borders where everyone became a citizen of the world. This globalist mentality was a foolish idea that ignored both human nature and it ignored the lessons of over 5,000 years of recorded human history. And it has cost us dearly.”

What is the fatal flaw of today’s globalism?

The Secretary of State correctly pinpointed the fatal flaw of today’s globalism: “human nature.”

What is the biblical view of human nature?

All people have a sinful (selfish) nature...

Jeremiah 17:9 – *The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; Who can know it?*

This vital truth is confirmed throughout Scripture...

Romans 3:23 – *for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God*

How do we know outside Scripture that people are not born innocent and become corrupted over time?

Look at children... their parents don’t teach them to be selfish; they come by it naturally. Children have to be taught not to act selfishly in order to socialize with others.

What is the perfect ideal of globalism?

What could be wrong with a world united together in harmony? Even popular science fiction series like Star Trek envision a future in which we have “evolved” past the supposedly barbaric concept of individual nations into a global system of governance.

- No more bloody wars, corruption, violations of human rights, hunger, and wicked regimes. Surely no one could argue against a future like that!

How are those opposed to globalism viewed by globalists?

To many, especially the young, those who fight against globalism are viewed as selfish, power-hungry, and lacking humanity.

What is really the motivation of those opposed to globalism?

Those who resist globalism do so out of wisdom... they see what globalism has already resulted in and its potential for tyranny...

- Equipped with an understanding of human nature and history, we know that globalism would not produce a worldwide “utopia” but rather the creation of a global regime—equipped with all the wicked qualities of human nature—whose power would be limitless. The danger is obvious.

How will those who oppose globalism fare?

It is a worthy thing to oppose globalism but the best that can be accomplished is to delay the inevitable...

Revelation 13:7 – *authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation*

God, who knows the future, told us that a day is coming when there will be a global government—and it looks nothing like the appealing picture of peace and harmony presented from the buildings of Davos.

What does the Bible reveal about the coming world government?

- This global government will fall under the rule of an individual whom the Bible refers to as the Antichrist.
- While he will come with lofty and deceptive words promising “peace,” his global regime will be blood-soaked and freedom-crushing.
- Its leader will impose his own religious system, and, like all good tyrants, he will demand to be worshipped as god (2 Thess. 2:3-4).
- Those who refuse will be unable to buy and sell and will be systematically killed (Rev 13:15-18).
- Jesus Christ will be the only one with the power to decisively end his rule—and He will do just that (Rev. 19:20, 2 Thess. 2:8).

How do we know that the coming global government will be tyrannical?

Daniel 7:23 – *The fourth beast shall be a fourth kingdom on earth, which shall be different from all other kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, trample it and break it in pieces.*

The Bible reveals that will be the case. All the examples of emerging tyranny in Western Civilization such as censorship, centralizing control of surveillance, and digital money foreshadow what is to come.

How have today’s globalist policies already “cost us dearly” (to use Rubio’s words)?

The push for open borders has resulted in disastrous mass immigration, the “climate cult” has impoverished societies, and the hostility toward national sovereignty has weakened the West and emboldened global bad actors.

What does the Bible have to say about the trend to surrender national sovereignty?

This trend foreshadows how the coming global government will come into power... referring to the 10 kings who will rule the world just prior to the Antichrist:

Revelation 17:12-13 – *they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast. These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast.*

In a world with global problems, the solution has to be a global government.

- In a world where no leader wants to take responsibility, the appeal must be made to a higher authority. And for the godless, the highest authority has to ultimately be global government.

Is “ideal globalism” even possible?

With God, all things are possible (Matthew 19:26)... The ideal global government can only happen when sinful human nature is no longer a factor.

- The Bible tells us that Jesus Christ will return to put an end to the Antichrist’s regime and establish a global kingdom for a thousand years, with Himself as the head.
- Those who rule and reign with Him will be resurrected saints—those who, through Christ’s shed blood, have had the chains of sinful human nature broken.

Can we really imagine a world where there will be no wars?

During the Millennial Kingdom, the world

“shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more” (Isaiah 2:4).

There will be no need to train for war, no injustice or government corruption, and no ideology driven suppression of freedom.

- People are not wrong to want to live in a world like that; however, ignoring sinful human nature and attempting to bring it about with the exclusion of Christ is a recipe for a disaster that is global in scope.

What is the prophetic significance of today’s nationalist versus globalist struggle?

God established the concept of nations at the Tower of Babel (Genesis 11), dividing humanity into distinct nation-states with borders and sovereignty.

- This divine institution of nationalism is meant to maintain social order and prevent the concentration of power under a single global authority.

The current globalist movement, which seeks to dissolve national borders and establish a one-world government, is a modern attempt to reverse God's division of nations.

- This movement aligns with Satan's plan to set up a global kingdom under the Antichrist during the Tribulation period.

The Bible predicts that ultimately, all nations will be brought under the dominion of the Antichrist, who will establish a worldwide government opposed to God.

What is ultimately going on in today’s tension between nationalism and globalism?

Ultimately, this is a spiritual battle. Nationalism represents God's ordained order, while globalism represents the satanic agenda to unify the world under a rebellious ruler.

- This struggle is not merely political but has profound prophetic implications, signaling the approach of the end times and the coming Tribulation.

Can the activism of nationalists keep the globalists from realizing their agenda?

It can certainly help delay it but God's Word says the globalists will have their day so there is nothing humanly possible to prevent it. And the globalists will effectively have no opposition when the Church is removed:

2 Thessalonians 2:7-8 – For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. And then the lawless one will be revealed

This passage is in the context of the rapture of the Church... the evil-restraining ministry of the Holy Spirit who indwells Christians will cease when the Church is removed from the earth.

How should Christians view today's struggle between nationalism and globalism?

Believers should understand this conflict from a biblical perspective, recognizing that supporting national sovereignty aligns with God's design, while globalism is part of the end-times deception.

- This awareness should lead Christians to pray, be discerning, and stand firm in their faith as the world moves closer to the end of the Age.

What applications do we see from our discussion today?

- The humanist vision of a utopian global government will fail miserably due to human nature.
- There is a functional global government coming that will be personally presided over by Jesus Christ.
- Today's struggle between nationalism and globalism reveals we are close to the end of the Church Age.
