What is the message of the “Coexist” bumper stickers?

The "Coexist" bumper sticker uses religious and ideological symbols to replace standard letters advocating for religious tolerance, interfaith dialogue, and peaceful coexistence among diverse cultures.

What emerging spiritual environment does the “Coexist” bumper sticker reflect?

The modern world is demanding people respond with the “right” answer to these questions:

- Is tolerance a higher virtue than truth?
- Is interfaith unity more important than doctrine?
- Is Biblical conviction now considered divisive?

We are witnessing the rise of what could be called:

The New Global Religion of Tolerance

How is the emergence of a global religion a significant end time development?

Revelation 17 & 18 indicate that there will be a global government, economy and religion.

What is required for diverse cultures and religions to coexist?

Tolerance... we are living in an age where tolerance has become the supreme virtue of modern society.

- Governments promote it.
- Corporations market it.
- Schools teach it.
- Media platforms enforce it.
- Religious leaders increasingly preach it.

Isn't tolerance a noble value?

Certainly, Christians are called to love people, show compassion, and treat others with dignity.

- But the modern definition of tolerance has evolved far beyond kindness or coexistence...

How has tolerance become the supreme virtue of today's culture?

Today, tolerance demands not merely accepting people... but affirming every belief system, lifestyle, ideology, and moral framework as equally valid.

- This is the fruit of the postmodern ideology that rejects absolute truth.

What happens in today's postmodern culture when someone proclaims there is absolute truth?

They are increasingly viewed as dangerous, divisive, hateful, or extreme.

- This is why the coming global culture is not merely political or social, it is spiritual.
- A new worldwide belief system is emerging, and its central doctrine is this: *truth must never offend*.

Today, tolerance demands affirmation, and anyone who refuses to affirm the spirit of the age is viewed as dangerous.

What is hate speech?

It is often defined as speech that dehumanizes others, incites violence, promotes harm or fear, and encourages hostility or discrimination.

How have hate speech laws been used to silence Christians?

Those who proclaim Biblical exclusivity—or refuse participation in certain interfaith movements—are increasingly being portrayed as intolerant, divisive, hateful, or dangerous.

- This is how uncompromising Christianity is gradually becoming described and received in our modern secular culture.

What is the objective of the various interfaith efforts in the world today?

They are promoting a growing emphasis on interfaith dialogue, global coexistence, and shared ethics over doctrine.

- In other words, what the world is accepting and seeking is ethics over truth and unity over doctrine.

Is tolerance between cultures and religions growing in the world today?

Despite the best efforts of the global elite, it is actually getting worse for two prophetically significant reasons:

Matthew 13:30 – *Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, “First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn.”*

Ultimately it is a spiritual issue and so these divisions will become more apparent as we near the time of harvest (end of the Age).

Matthew 24:7 – *For nation will rise against nation...*
These divisions are a birth pang of the return of Jesus.

Why has resolving the conflict between cultures and religions such a big issue for the global elite?

The world is searching desperately for unity. But increasingly, it wants unity without Biblical truth.

The former Pope spoke of “spiritual sensibilities...” what exactly does that mean?

The language itself reflects a growing global movement away from doctrinal certainty and toward broad spiritual inclusiveness.

- Truth becomes secondary to coexistence.
- Doctrine becomes less important than dialogue.

Why is truth more important than coexistence?

Truth is the foundation for spiritual health, freedom, and faithful obedience to God, it must come first...

John 8:32 – *you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free*

Unity that compromises truth is not true unity but a kind of false peace.

- When we exchange truth for mere tolerance, we keep people imprisoned in error instead of leading them to genuine freedom in Christ.

Why is truth so important?

Truth defines reality and exposes what needs fixing.

- Truth doesn't tell us what we want to hear; it tells us what we need to hear so healing and repentance can begin.

How does truth cause division?

Truth draws a line between reality and falsehood...

Hebrews 4:12 – *For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.*

If the church fears controversy and waters down doctrine to avoid division, it ceases to be a cleansing witness in the world.

What does it lead to when tolerance is seen as the supreme moral good?

This creates a dangerous progression.... Disagreement becomes hate, exclusivity becomes dangerous, and Biblical conviction becomes divisive.

How is Christianity exclusive?

Jesus declared in John 14:6 – *“I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.”*

Acts 4:12 – *And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.*

These verses, and others, directly contradict the spirit of religious universalism.

How is “shared ethics” replacing the gospel?

One of the defining characteristics of this emerging system is the replacement of doctrine with shared ethics.

- We now see calls for morality without repentance, spirituality without salvation, unity without truth, and compassion without conviction.

The message sounds appealing: *“Let us focus on what unites us.”*

How is it that biblical Christianity cannot separate love from truth?

The Bible presents love and truth as inseparable characteristics of God and of mature Christian life.

Ephesians 4:15 – *but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all [aspects] into Him who is the head, Christ*

The most loving thing a person can do is share the truth with someone who needs to hear it.

How is human cooperation related to the Gospel?

The Gospel is not merely about human cooperation. It is about reconciliation to God through Jesus Christ.

What spiritual condition is reflected in teaching unity through compromising with the world?

It is an end-of-the-Church-Age condition...

2 Timothy 4:3–4 – *For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine...*

People will prefer messages that affirm their desires rather than be confronted with the truth.

What is the role of deception in the coming global religion?

The Bible repeatedly speaks of a future global spiritual deception associated with the last days.

- 2 Thessalonians 2 describes the rise of the “*lawless one*” accompanied by deception powerful enough to mislead the world.
- Revelation describes a future global system that will influence nations spiritually, politically, and economically.

As the world embraces unity without truth, Biblical Christianity increasingly stands alone. This is one of the great prophetic realities of our time.

How is the infrastructure for global spiritual convergence forming today?

Through various interfaith initiatives: Abrahamic faith movement, shared worship spaces, global religious summits, “common faith” language, and worldwide calls for religious harmony.

- None of these trends alone fulfill prophecy, but together, they reveal the direction of the world.

How will the world be deceived into embracing religious unity?

The greatest deception of the last days may not come through obvious evil.

- It may come through a counterfeit love that rejects Biblical truth in the name of peace and unity.

How does the Bible contradict the world’s narrative that we should “*affirm everything*”?

1 John 4:1 – *Test the spirits whether they are of God*
How does one do that? By acknowledging who Jesus is, Lord of lords and King of kings.

- This is not the hour for compromise.
- It is the hour for discernment.

The closer the world moves toward unity without Christ, the closer it moves toward the fulfillment of Bible prophecy.

What will become of the emerging global religion?

It will be used by the global elite to serve their purposes of uniting everyone under them but it will be discarded after it has served that purpose...

Revelation 17:16 – *And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire.*

What applications do we see from our discussion today?

The culture’s efforts to compromise truth for the sake of unity sets the stage for the coming global religion thus revealing we are at the end of the Church Age.
