Notice of Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREGY GIVEN that a public hearing by the Georgetown Divide Recreation District Board of Directors will be held on July 27, 2020, at 4:30 PM, at the District Office, 4300 Highway 49, Pilot Hill, CA, for the purpose considering the proposed adoption of :

Ordinance No. 1

An Ordinance of the Georgetown Divide Recreation District Establishing Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of District Parks and Facilities

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT desires to enact by ordinance a set of Rules and Regulations governing the use of DISTRICT parks and facilities; and

WHEREAS the staff of the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT has drafted and proposed a complete set of Rules and Regulations governing the conduct of persons using the DISTRICT's parks and facilities; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT deems it necessary to enact by ordinance said Rules and Regulations for the purpose of promoting community health, safety and the general welfare of persons using DISTRICT parks and facilities, and for the protection and preservation of DISTRICT resources and facilities; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT, at its regular meeting held on July 27, 2020, validly waived the first reading, reviewed, discussed and considered the enactment of this Ordinance, and directed staff to post and advertise the content of this Ordinance.

THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT does ordain as follows:

IT IS ORDAINED that the Rules and Regulations as set forth herein be and hereby are adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall not be construed to implicitly or explicitly repeal any other ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, as of the effective date of this Ordinance, July 27, 2020, all the parks and facilities owned and maintained by the GEORGETOWN DIVIDE RECREATION DISTRICT shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations enacted hereunder; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, any offences under this Ordinance shall be governed and prosecuted under the provisions of this Ordinance, and any offences which are continuing in nature and which also constitute a violation of this Ordinance may also be prosecuted under this Ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, should any section or provision of the Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, this decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, the Board of Directors hereby declaring that it would have passed those parts of the Ordinance which are valid, and omitted any parts which may be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid if it had known that such part(s) were invalid at the time of the of the adoption of this Ordinance.

Summary of Ordinance No. 1 – Rules and Regulations

Ordinance No. 1 – Rules and regulations sets specific rules and regulations for the use of District Parks and facilities that the District operates for the public. The Rules and Regulations are deemed necessary for the purpose of promoting community health, safety, and the general welfare of persons using District Park and District operated facilities.

In addition to existing law controlling behaviors and use of controlled substances, the District’s Rules and Regulations also restrict the use of alcoholic beverages, and tobacco in and around District Parks and operated facilities to prohibit possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages at Georgetown Park unless by District authorized permit, and to prohibit the smoking of tobacco within 100 feet of District playground facilities.
