Don't be afraid to use my name.

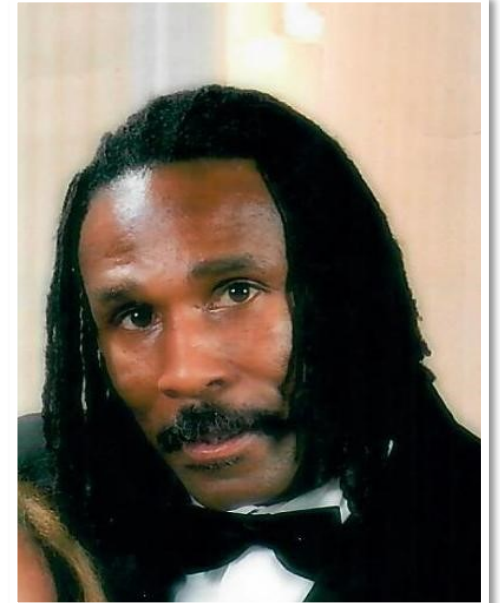
Let your sorrow last for just a while.
