GENEALOGY, THE GOVERNOR & YOU

Texas Governor Beauford Jester, was the second in his family to get involved in politics. Governor Jester's grandmother's sister recalled vividly that her Mother didn't want to leave the known to venture the unknown in Texas. To get to Texas from Louisiana she remembered crossing the Mississippi River on a ferry boat which was popular in the late 1800s. Jester's great- aunt made a statement of entering Texas by crossing the Red River. She was an impressionable child at the time, and had never seen a red river. Decades, upon decades passed and she never forgot the image of the red river. It never left her mind. She was astonished that the actual color of the river was red. The Jester's came from Indiana. Levi Jester had little or no intention of uprooting his family to move to Texas. His stubbornness simply wasn't in the stars. Levi died leaving his wife and children no option except to move to Texas where her parents, sister and brothers had moved earlier. When the life of Levi was no more, his widow Diadema packed her children in a covered wagon, and headed to Texss to be where she knew her Mother, Father and siblings were living. Diadema and her children might have camped at one of the same creeks where her parents and siblings had camped years earlier. You'd Camp at Richland creek or Chambers creek, if your destination was the City of Corsicana. Which meant you had arrived. It also meant, you were close to Corsicana where Levi & Diadema Jester's son George would enter into politics. George would meet one of the infamous fundraisers for the Corsicana Public Library, Maude Gordon, and he would marry Maude's daughter Frances. George and Frances Jester's son, Maude's grandson, would become Governor of Texas.

CHAPTER 4

Go-To Coaching with Mrs. Stubbs, the Director of Genealogy, Corsicana Public Library. In her Pearls of Wisdom for the perfected interview. We begin with a video on the AncestryThread website. Here Mrs. Stubbs is seated off-camera. First Pearl of Wisdom: Always give vour subject or the Interviewee the CU - (Close-Up). An analysis of how well everything worked is conducted every 2 years and 6 Months. In the short video everything prominent is covered. In her Second Pearl of Wisdom: The interviewer must come to the interview prepared. Listen as Mrs. Stubbs is focused on Catherine Porter, (deceased), a well respected knowledgeable citizen of Pelham, Texas. certain steps fall in place. Her steps are small conceived with patience. Mrs. Stubbs wants the year confirmed by the person who was an eyewitness. The Interviewee has a memory lapse. Mrs. Stubbs handles it professionally, by quickly stating the date and moving on to the next question. Third Pearl of Wisdom, "Never let the Interviewer feel embarrassed. There are only secondary sources alive today for the 1800s Interview. A trip on a ferry boat could bring back memories just as rapid as a wagon travel overland. The reminiscence could bring the world to a halt if there was anyone living today who could tell the story. The Red River is filled with witnesses of the Red River in the past of people who actually saw firsthand that the river was indeed red. The cost to travel overland or by ferry was costly either way. If you travelled by ferry boat you paid out of pocket, and if you travelled overland God help, you might have paid dear life. If you listen close you'll hear on the video Mrs. Porter stressing how when the gin was burning her sister was screaming how everyone was going to die, and how her brother was driving with excessive speed. Mrs. Stubbs had to have been focused on the interview as opposed to the storytelling. Which is Mrs. Stubbs fourth Pearl of Wisdom: Do not get drawn into the storytelling and forget the purpose of the interview. When traveling overland everything was compliant. On the ferry boat, the Captain make that

decision for you. Coaching is much like travel by ferry boat. The coach is there to help you to grasp a better feel for what's important. Genealogy is a game of names for the wise. Learning new words like patrilineal and matrilineal are good when you have full comprehension of their meaning. You want to be coached gently enough for you to make your own discoveries like a written confirmation. You want your especially names confirmed. Which brings us to our final Pearl of Wisdom:!Remember to write names down. Mrs. Stubbs sealed the deal by asking for the names of her brother and sister. We learn her sisters name was Martha, and her brothers name was Booker T. A great interview for under 10 minutes.
