Revelation 1:5-6

On April 12th, we will begin a new Wednesday Bible Study (at New Hope!) on the book of Revelation. This will be a structured study using *Revelation* by Stephen Witmer from *The Knowing the Bible* series. No need to worry about acquiring the book, I will provide it on the first night. All you need to do is show up!

When hearing a phrase like "Biblical prophecy," we often think first of what Scripture informs us about the future. It is true that the doctrine of eschatology has an informative purpose. Indeed, the book of Revelation spans the entire church age, from the first-century church (the Apostle John addressed the book to the seven churches of Asia) to the glorious second coming of Jesus Christ.

Nevertheless, in Scripture, prophecies always have a greater purpose than just providing details about future. In fact, in many ways, Scripture, including Revelation, only paints the big picture of what will happen. It does not give us every precise detail that we might want to know. One of the key aims of Revelation is to offer a strong assurance that since Jesus has already won victory over sin and death through his atoning sacrifice on the cross, the believer can endure through this life, remaining faithful to God and obedient to His Word, knowing that the New Heaven and New Earth awaits him or her.

Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, John did not write Revelation to simply satisfy our curiosity about what will happen in the end. In Scripture, prophecies are given primarily to transform how believers think and live. In the verses above, the purpose of Revelation is to point us to Jesus, who loves us, and has freed us from our sins, and has made us a Kingdom of priests. Thus, by studying Revelation, we will learn about our precious salvation in Christ Jesus and about our purpose as His people, the church. By God's grace, the study of Revelation will lead us a greater and purer worship.

There is nothing more we could ask for. I pray that you will make it a priority to join us on April 12th at 6:30 as we begin this important study.
