1 Peter 2:9 "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light."

New Hope faces an uncertain future. Many of you are saddened to see how our church has decreased in active attendance over the last 20 years. You may even struggle to understand why God has not blessed us with greater numerical growth. I feel this way too.

However, I would cautious us with two clarifications. First, it is important to recognize that the numerical decline at New Hope is not an isolated problem. Most churches in our country have experienced significant numerical decline. We are living in a post-Christian country. Nevertheless, this does not reflect a failure in God's church. The Gospel is as powerful as ever and still produces a great harvest. The universal church remains strong. As our Lord Jesus said, "On this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it" (Matt. 16:18).

Just because our experience of the church at New Hope may not live up to our expectations for the church that does not neglect the significance and impact of the church as a whole. I still believe that the church, the Body of Christ, is one of God's most precious blessings and that the church, God's people, remains the foremost avenue in which He uses to accomplish His purposes in this world.

But second, and this is crucial, we should never take for granted the work of God at New Hope, even when there is no immediate numerical growth. Every act of obedience to God's Word, every prayer and supplication offered to God, every expression of Christ-like love, every humble and selfless deed done for the welfare of another person, and every word of encouragement is an indication of God's gracious work in and through us. This recognition will keep us joyful and grateful even when it feels that we have more questions than answers and we do not know what's next for our church. Assuming that New Hope is a place of faithful Bible study, consistent prayer, and true fellowship among believers, we need not worry about all the unknowns. We can trust God and know that, in His timing, He will take care of us and lead us to where we need to be.

More than ever our congregation needs to seek God's will for our church, and His power to obey. As we do, we must remember the high privilege of being counted as God's people and the high calling of proclaiming the Good News that salvation is available in God's Son, the Lord Jesus. We may have to make some very difficult decisions in the days ahead, but as we do, we cannot afford to lose sight of who we are as the church. As 1 Peter 2 says, we are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of God's own possession, who joyfully proclaim who wonderful and excellent God is!

New Hope, this is who you are. Believe it.




#### **Clothing Closet**
