1 Peter 2:2-3 "Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation— if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good."

Every New Year provides a sense of hope. It offers a refreshing opportunity to make improvements in our lives. The spirit of the New Year is summarized well by Mother Teresa, who once said, "Yesterday is gone. Tomorrow has not yet come. We have only today. Let us begin." As we enter 2024, I pray that we will renew our devotion to God's Word and learn what Jesus meant by, "Man shall not live on bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."

In 1 Peter 2:2, believers are called to desire God's Word like a newborn baby desires milk. It must be the pure spiritual milk of the Word. We cannot settle for a counterfeit or a water-downed version, which can cause sickness or death. A water-downed Gospel does not save and will not produce holy living. The word "desire" is a strong term that describes an intense personal craving. Just as a little baby emerges from his or her mother's womb crying for her milk, so too should the believer hunger for God's Word. Do you hunger for God's Word?

Unfortunately, study after study indicates a growing biblical illiteracy among Americans, even among self-identifying "Christians." How can we claim to love God if we show little concern and desire for His Holy Word? In 1 Peter 2:2, we need the milk of God's Word for sanctification; to grow up into salvation. Just as a baby needs the nourishment of milk to grow physically, a Christian needs the nourishment of God's word to grow spiritually. There is no lasting obedience, abundant joy and confident faith without a growing love of God's Word.

Reading, studying and obeying God's Word is not burdensome. It is no heavy toll on the journey of Christian life. Indeed, it is a pathway of the abundant joy that Jesus offers. When calling believers to desire God's Word, Peter adds an interesting conditional statement in v. 3, "if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good." God's Word provides the continuous blessing of knowing the Lord's goodness. To drink the milk of the Word is to taste again and again what the Lord is like and to experience again and again the joy of personal fellowship with the Lord. We forfeit so much of the joy of our relationship with Christ when we forsake our duty to know His Word. I pray that will never be the case at New Hope in 2024.


